APPETIZER RADIO HOUR Sun., 6:00 pm, weekly, 1 hr. Host D. Grant Smith serves up the listener's connection to new and emerging artists along with established legends each week.

BETWEEN THE LINES Thurs., 6:00 pm. A weekly, half-hour syndicated news magazine featuring progressive perspectives on national and international political, economic, and social issues.

BIG PICTURE SCIENCE Sat., 9:00 am, weekly, 1 hr. A program that connects ideas about the origins, the behavior, and the future of life and technology on Earth in surprising and playful ways.

BLUEGRASS REVIEW Sat., 10:00 am (rebroadcast: 9:00 pm, Mon.), weekly, 1 hr. Phil Nusbaum hosts "Bluegrass Music's Authoritative Radio Home" out of Minneapolis. Each show contains Gems of Bluegrass, interviews, and thematic presentation.

BOOKWAVES Mon., 6:30 pm, weekly, half-hour. Produced in Berkeley, California, this half-hour program is about books and their authors.

BUILDING BRIDGES Wed. 6:00 pm. half-hour. Radio from the grassroots, a weekly news magazine from community stations across the country.
